Lost People Found – Where are they lost and in need of being found?

No matter where we find ourselves in our faith journey, there is always an area of our life that we may feel lost within (i.e. salvation, finances, career, etc).

Facilitation Questions:

- Where do you feel stuck right now?
- What is one area of your life that you would like to see change?
- What is keeping you from going “all-in” with your relationship with God?

Found People Free – Where are they in need of freedom through community?

God not only desires His people to be found, but He desires freedom for us, as His children. We believe that healing often comes in the context of community.

Facilitation Questions:

- What area of your life (if any), are you in need of healing?
- Where do you need to be challenged in your relationship with God?
- Where do you need to be challenged in your relationship with others?

Free People Empowered – Where can they use their gifts and talents within this House?

God equipped His saints for the work of the ministry and we love nothing more than seeing people use their gifts and talents to advance His Kingdom.

Facilitation Questions:

- Have you been through the Empowerment Track?
- Are you currently serving?
- Where in your life do you feel strong? Did you know you could use those strengths for God?

Possible Next Steps:

- Joining Empowerment Track
- Joining a Weekend Serve Team
- Joining a Central Serve Team (i.e. Events, Photography, etc)

Empowered People Making Kingdom Impact – Where can they use their influence for His Kingdom?

For some, God gives the gift of leadership, and what better way to use that gift than for Kingdom purposes?

Facilitation Questions:

- Where do you have influence in your life?
- How can you begin to use that influence (time, treasure, talent) for God's Kingdom?
- How would you feel about leading a Serve Team or Group?

Possible Next Steps:

- Leading a Group as a Co-Leader
- Leading a Serve Team as a Service Captain or Admin Coordinator
- Leading in Empowerment Track as a Co-Connector
- Mentoring Students at Collide

In every next step given, consider our 5 Core Values. This is how we disciple those we lead.
