

THE ROLE AND THE WIN

NEXT LEVEL KIDS PRE-K THREE'S – FIVE'S ROOM LEADER ASSIST.

Who do I report to? Next Level Kids Pre-K Coach

What is the goal of this role? Creating a safe and loving place where 3 through 5-year-olds can experience the love of God through engaging lessons from the Bible so that they know 1) God Made Me, 2) God Loves Me, 3) Jesus wants to be my friend forever.

How do I define the wins?

1. **Touch someone's heart today!**
2. **See** – Offer a warm greeting to every child as you welcome them into a clean, safe, and fun environment.
3. **Connect** – Free up the Room Leader to be able to connect with parents to offer confidence that their child is being loved and cared for while they're in service.
4. **Hope** – Offer hope to every child by engaging them quickly in biblical lessons and activities.

How do I reach the wins?

1. Work with the Room Leader to help create a welcoming extraordinary experience through seeing, connecting, and offering hope to every parent and child.
2. Assist the Room Leader by following all classroom guidelines and safety procedures.
3. Engage the children as soon as they enter your room, so the parents feel confident leaving their child in your care.
4. Familiarize yourself with the lesson and activities before serving and remain engaged through curriculum activities with each child.

What skills are needed to win?

1. Assist and help when asked and even when not asked.
2. Relationship building, friendly, & fun attitude.
3. Love teaching three-five-year old's

What makes my role valuable to the team? The Pre-K Room Leader Assistant helps ensure three-five year old's are cared for and loved on while their parents experience church. They get to help children learn and experience how much God loves them.
