NEXT LEVEL KIDS PRE-K THREE'S – FIVE'S ROOM LEADER

Who do I report to? Next Level Kids Pre-K Coach

What is the goal of this role? Creating a safe and loving place where 3 through 5-year-olds can experience the love of God through engaging lessons from the Bible so that they know 1) God Made Me, 2) God Loves Me, 3) Jesus wants to be my friend forever.

How do I define the wins?

1. **Touch someone's heart today!**
2. **See** – Invite parents and three-five-year-old's into a safe, clean, and fun environment using planned activities.
3. **Connect** – Build relationships with parents of Pre-K aged children by helping both the parent and child feel safe.
4. **Hope** – Offer hope to every parent by providing encouragement and resources they can use to be spiritual champions at home.

How do I reach the wins?

1. Create a welcoming extraordinary experience through seeing, connecting, and offering hope with every parent.
2. Assume ownership of the room and follow cleaning guidelines and safety procedures.
3. Establish and build relationships with parents by partnering with them through life giving interactions, resources and support.
4. Familiarize yourself with the lesson and activities by serving and remain engaged through curriculum activities with each child.

What skills are needed to win?

1. Attention to detail.
2. Relationship building & friendly attitude.
3. Love teaching three-five-year old's

What makes my role valuable to the team?

The Pre-K Room Leader takes charge of the room and ensures that three-five-year old's are cared for and loved on while their parents experience church. They get to help children learn and experience how much God loves them.
