

THE ROLE AND THE WIN

MENTOR

Who do I report to? Mentor Coach

What is the goal of this role? To facilitate meaningful discussion in safe environments where students are known, loved, and challenged to grow in authentic faith and community.

How do I define the wins?

1. **Touch someone's heart today!**
2. **See** – Students begin to see themselves how God sees them, with the potential to make an impact for the Kingdom, because of the way their mentors sees and encourages them.
3. **Connect** – Students build authentic relationships with their mentor and with other students their age.
4. **Hope** – Students leave each week with courage and excitement to take their next step in their relationship with God.

How do I reach the wins?

1. Connect with students throughout the week and be intentional about being consistently available.
2. Speak life and wisdom over students, speaking truth and pointing them to scripture.
3. Lead students in meaningful discussions about the message using the small group questions provided and encourage all student to participate in conversation.
4. Offer opportunities for growth and next steps each Wednesday.

What skills are needed to win?

1. Be passionate about leading middle school and/or high school students.
2. Good communication skills & ability to facilitate small group conversation that allows students to grow in their relationship with Jesus.
3. Willingness to abide by the Biblical Standards for Spiritual Leadership.

What makes my role valuable to the team? Student Mentors provide the intentional discipleship students need to grow their faith, build lasting, authentic relationships, and be challenged to take their next step in becoming a fully engaged follower of Jesus.
