

THE ROLE AND THE WIN

STUDENT SAFETY TEAM

Who do I report to? Student Experience Coach or Location Safety Coach

What is the goal of this role? To observe and monitor student environments to prevent or mitigate circumstances that would detract from the safety and security of the services or events, provide leadership during emergencies in collaboration with other Collide teams, and to demonstrate the love of Jesus with everyone whom God has given you influence.

How do I define the wins?

1. **Touch someone's heart today!**
2. **See** – Safety concerns with students or adults are found and addressed before issues arise.
3. **Connect** – Team Members are viewed as positive influences on students.
4. **Hope** – Safety Teams worked collaboratively with other Student Ministry Teams to provide a sense of safety for everyone in attendance so that parents feel confident leaving their kids in the care of our Student Team.

How do I reach the wins?

1. Remember that love is the motive for everything we do.
2. Stay alert and focused on assigned areas. Minimize distractions and maximize attentiveness.
3. Interact and engage students and teams with a welcoming attitude.
4. Regularly attend trainings and stay up to date on Safety Team communication.

What skills are needed to win?

1. Be passionate about students having a safe environment for them to become fully engaged followers of Jesus.
2. Be willing to learn systems, procedures and policies necessary for Collide Safety.
3. Be Dedicated to the vision, mission, and House Rules of Collide.

What makes my role valuable to the team? The Student Safety Team provides a safe and comfortable environment for students to become fully engaged followers of Jesus and for Team Members to be able to focus on discipling.
