Who do I report to? Student Experience Coach

What is the goal of this role? The Set Up/Tear Down team helps create a safe and fun environment that encourages students to become fully engaged followers of Jesus.

How do I define the wins?

2. **See** – See the environment from the perspective a student walking in, and ensure that it is set up, safe, and ready to for students to grow in their relationship with Jesus.

3. Strive for unity, teamwork, and stewarding time well before and after Wednesday night student services.
4. Come prepared to create a safe and fun environment for middle and high school students.
