

THE ROLE AND THE WIN

STREET TEAM MEMBER

Who do I report to? Student Leadership Coach

What is the goal of this role? The heart of a Street Team Member is to connect students into ongoing engagement and build relationships with other students and leaders on the weekends.

How do I define the wins?

1. **Touch someone's heart today!**
2. **See** – Engage with every student and their families before and after weekend services.
3. **Connect** – New students are introduced to a Student Staff or Student Impact Team Member and invited to attend a Wednesday night service or event.
4. **Hope** – Students new to weekend services feel special and loved from the moment they walk arrive, to the moment they leave.

How do I reach the wins?

1. Welcome students with a smile and get to know their name and school they attend.
2. Invite all students to sit in the Student Section.
3. Be ready with information to share about Next Level Student Ministry.
4. Leave all students with a next step towards further engagement.

What skills are needed to win?

1. Passion for more students becoming involved and engaged.
2. Available with your time and energy to connect students to everything Next Level Church has to offer them.
3. Warm, welcoming, and friendly.
4. Committed to the Student Ministry House Rules.

What makes my role valuable to the team? Student Weekend Engagement Team Members are the bridge for students finding community within our church. They connect students into ongoing engagement and help them build relationships with other students and leaders.
