

## THE ROLE AND THE WIN

### STUDENT WORSHIP TEAM (See Worship Playbook for more details)

**Who do I report to?** Student Worship Coach

**What is the goal of this role?** To lead students in worship by coming prepared, expectant, and responding in worship.

**How do I define the wins?**

1. **Touch Someone's Heart Today!**
2. **See** – See where the hearts of God's people are as you lead them and the team into worship.
3. **Connect** – Connect people to the worship by “Owning your Zone” and “Playing your Part.”
4. **Hope** – Leave people with hope by worshipping freely.

**How do I reach the wins?**

1. Come to the huddles and spend time preparing your heart in prayer prior to service.
2. Lead the zone in front of you through your expression of worship.
3. Practice throughout the week and establish the parts you are playing before rehearsal.
4. Remember why we do what we do, to bring glory to God.

**What skills are needed to win?**

1. The ability to engage the congregation through non-verbal communication.
2. Proficiency in your instrument.
3. Spiritual maturity that goes beyond the music.

**What makes my role valuable to the team?**

The Student Worship Team Members bring the sound of worship to our services. They lead the students through the journey of the songs we sing to bring glory to God.
